

“Bringing hope to the hopeless; leading both spiritual and physical orphans to the Father-heart of God”

Our definition of a spiritual orphan is, someone who has not yet been born-again into the family of God; who has not been lead to salvation, and is not yet adopted as a son of God.

Our focus in ministry until this point (and will continue as part of our overall vision), has been sharing the Gospel and making disciples, reaching out to the spiritual orphans in our village, as we have been slowly working with the resources God has given to purchase and develop FHF, so that we can care for physical orphans.

Our definition of a physical orphan is, a child who is left orphaned by the death of their parents. At FHF, theses orphans are our focus for the children’s center, although on a case-by-case basis, we are open to God’s leading in also working with “social orphans” (abused or abandoned) who may in fact have family, but are unable to live with them - for a time or permanently.
